ORDER 2015**


Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order: -

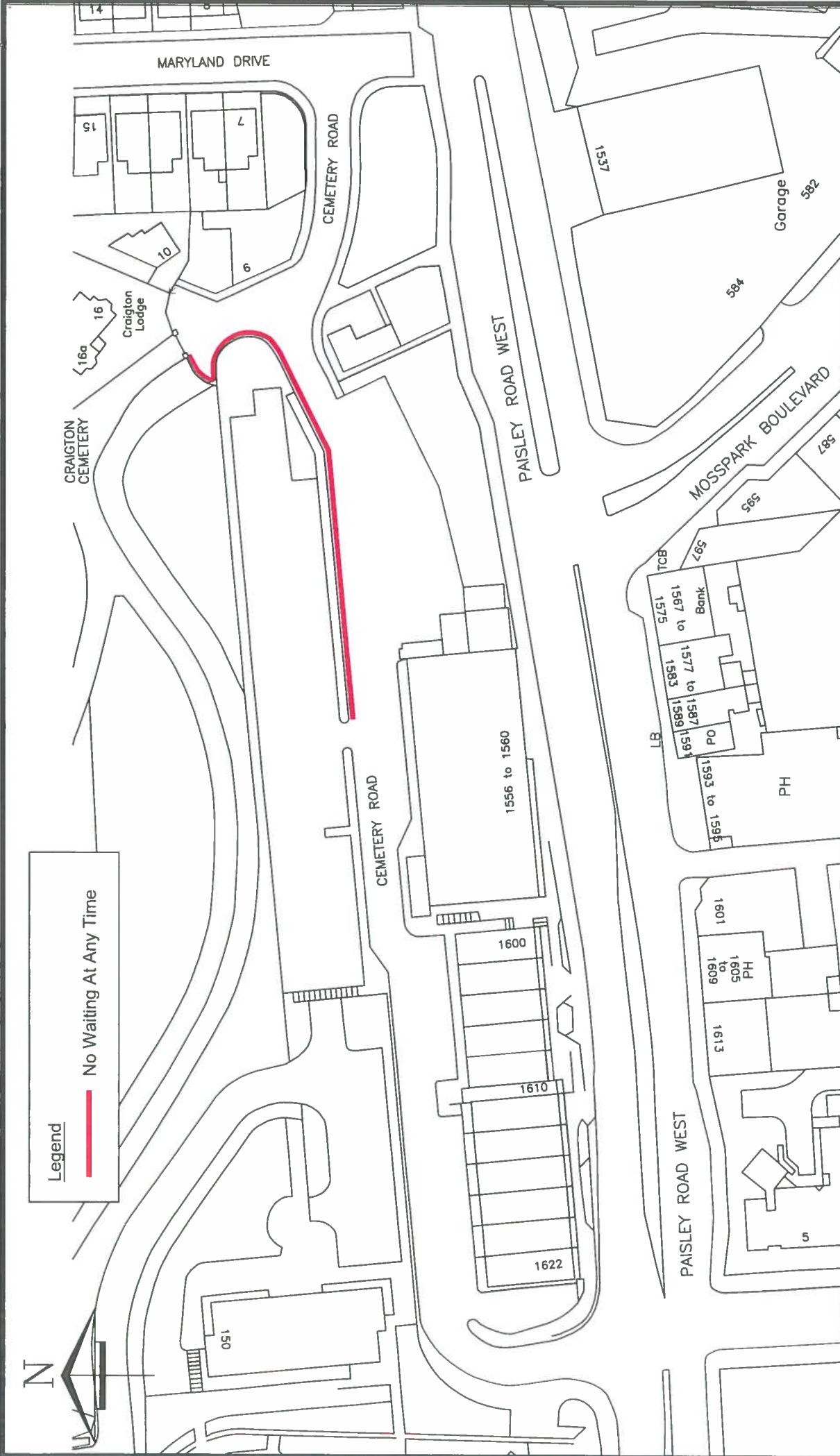
1. This Order may be cited as "Glasgow City Council (Cemetery Road) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2015" which will come into effect at 00:00 hours on Monday 6th July 2015 until such times as the Order is revoked.
2. This Order makes it unlawful for any person, except upon the direction or with the permission of a police constable in uniform, to cause or permit any vehicle to wait at any time on the following road:-

Cemetery Road, from the west side of the entrance gate at Craigton cemetery to a point 127m west of the extended west kerblines of Maryland Drive.
(on the north side of the carriageway)
