**(GEORGE SQUARE DISABLED VEHICLES PARKING PLACES, TAXI STANCE
AND LOADING BAY GLASGOW)**

(TEMPORARY TRAFFIC REGULATION)

ORDER 2015

Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Schedule 1 of the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991, and of all other enabling powers, hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as "Glasgow City Council (**George Square Disabled Parking Places, Taxi Stance and Loading Bay** Glasgow) (Temporary Traffic Regulation) Order 2015" which will come into effect at 0001 hours on Monday 27 April 2015 until the completion of the works.
2. This Order makes it unlawful for any person to drive or cause or permit to be driven or park any motor vehicle on the following road(s):-

WAITING AND LOADING

George Square North: the 6 marked disabled bays on the south side, for a distance of 60 metres or thereby eastwards from George Square west.

CLASSES OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED

All vehicles except those displaying a valid Blue Badge

WAITING AND LOADING

George Square North: the taxi stance on the north side, for a distance of 45 metres or thereby westwards from North Hanover Street.

CLASSES OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED

All vehicles except taxis

WAITING AND LOADING

George Square North: loading bay on the north side, for a distance of 25 metres or thereby eastwards from George Square west.

CLASSES OF VEHICLES PROHIBITED

All vehicles except Delivery vehicles
