Glasgow City Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them under sections 2(1) and 152(2) of the Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland hereby make the following Order:-

Citation and Commencement

This Order may be cited as "The Glasgow City Council (Yoker to Knightswood) (Redetermination of Means of Access of Public Right of Passage) Order 2018" and shall come into operation on 16th April 2018

The Interpretation Act 1978 shall apply for the interpretation of this Order as it applies to an Act of Parliament.

Redetermination of means of exercise of public right of passage.

The lengths of road in Glasgow specified in the schedule of this Order, at present footway, shall become cycle tracks, the right of passage being exercisable on pedal and foot only.

Dyke Road.

The length of existing footway on the Eastern side, from the extended south kerblines of Alderman Road to the extended north kerblines of Holehouse Drive.

Lincoln Avenue.

The length of existing footway on the Western side, from the extended north kerblines of Alderman Road to the extended south kerblines of Loanfoot Avenue.

Archerhill Road.

The length of existing footway on both sides, from the extended Western kerblines of Lincoln Avenue to the extended eastern kerblines of Bard Avenue.
