


PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

THE PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (NEW SCONE TRAFFIC
MANAGEMENT) (VARIATION) (NO 3) ORDER 2011
(19/11)

The Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 32, 35, 44, 45, 46, 49, and 53, and Part IV of Schedule 9 and Schedule 10 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as "the Perth and Kinross Council (New Scone Traffic Management) (Variation) (No. 3) Order 2011" and shall come into operation on the Fifth day of November Two Thousand and eleven.
2. The Perth and Kinross Council (New Scone Traffic Management) Order 1998 is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the Schedule to this Order.

The Perth and Kinross Council (New Scone Traffic Management) Order 1998 requires to be varied as follows:-

In PART I GENERAL PROVISIONS

Interpretation

Delete the sections "**disabled person**", "**disabled persons badge**" & "**disabled persons vehicle**" in their entirety and substitute with the following:-

"**disabled person**" means a disabled person of a description prescribed by Regulation 4 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"**disabled persons' badge**" has the meaning assigned to it by Regulation 11 of the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000;

"**disabled persons' vehicle**" means a motor vehicle which is displaying a disabled persons badge being used in accordance with the Disabled Persons (Badges for Motor Vehicles) (Scotland) Regulations 2000.

"**disabled persons' parking place**" means an area of a road designated solely for the parking of disabled persons vehicles.

Delete the section "**public service bus**" in its entirety.

2. In Part II PROHIBITIONS AND RESTRICTIONS

After **Designation of Parking Places** part 5

Add and insert the following:-

Disabled Persons' Parking Places

5A No person shall, except upon the direction or with the permission of a person duly authorised in that behalf by the Council, cause or permit any vehicle other than a disabled persons vehicle to wait at any time in any length of road specified in **PART V** of the Schedule.

In PART III EXEMPTIONS

3. At section **Public Service Bus**

Delete the paragraph after the number 12. and insert the words **Not Used**

SCHEDULE

The Schedule to the Perth and Kinross Council (New Scone Traffic Management) Order 1998 requires to be varied as follows:-

4. In **PART IV**

**WAITING LIMITED TO 30 MINUTES
RETURN PROHIBITED WITHIN 30 MINUTES-
(MONDAY TO SATURDAY) (8.30 AM TO 5.30PM)**

At **2 PERTH ROAD**

(b) West and Northwest side thereof

(ii) In line one after the words from a point delete number "89" and substitute with "95" and in line three after the words for a distance of delete number "31" and substitute with "19"

5. Delete the existing **PART V** and insert the following

PART V

DISABLED PERSONS' PARKING PLACE

1 PERTH ROAD

- (i) From a point 89 metres or thereby southwestwards from the intersection of the extended kerbline thereof with the extended kerbline of Mansfield Road southwestwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
- (ii) From a point 114 metres or thereby southwestwards from the intersection of the extended kerbline thereof with the extended kerbline of Mansfield Road southwestwards for a distance of 6 metres or thereby.
