**PERTH AND KINROSS COUNCIL (CRIEFF TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT)
(VARIATION) (NO 3) ORDER 2017
(NO 23/17)**

Perth and Kinross Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 1, 2, 3, 4 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (which Act of 1984 is hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Constable in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act hereby make the following Order:-

- 1 This Order may be cited as the "Perth and Kinross Council (Crieff Traffic Management) (Variation) (No 3) Order 2017" and shall come into operation on the Eighteenth day of November Two thousand and seventeen.
- 2 Perth and Kinross Council (Crieff Traffic Management) Order 2015 is hereby varied and shall henceforth have effect subject to the amendments thereto specified and described in the Schedule to this Order.

(VARIATION) (NO 3) ORDER 2017
SCHEDULE**

The Perth and Kinross Council (Crieff Traffic Management) Order 2015 requires to be varied as follows:-

- At **PART I, GENERAL PROVISIONS, Interpretation, 2.(i)** after “caravan” insert the following:-

““**cashless payment**” means payment received by digital transaction through media such as mobile telephone, mobile application, or computer.”

- In the **Articles, PART III**, delete the wording of **17 (2)** and substitute with:-

“The parking charge shall be payable on leaving the vehicle in the parking place by the insertion of one or more coins in a ticket issuing machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left, or payment made via a cashless payment method displayed on the ticket issuing machine, or by obtaining a 15 minute free parking ticket from a ticket issuing machine relating to the parking place in which the vehicle is left and only one such ticket shall be obtained per Parking period.”

- In the **Articles, PART III**, delete the wording of **17 (3)** and substitute with:-

“Upon payment of the parking charge for the vehicle the driver thereof shall exhibit on the vehicle in accordance with the provisions of paragraph (4) and (5) of this Article the ticket issued by the ticket issuing machine. If a cashless payment method is used, no ticket shall be exhibited on the vehicle.”

The Schedule to the Perth and Kinross Council (Crieff Traffic Management) Order 2015 requires to be varied as follows:-

- Delete the entire Parking Charge table and substitute with the following:-

Council Reasons

The Report No 15/227 to the Enterprise and Infrastructure Committee on the 3 June 2015 brought changes to the Controlled Parking Zone within Perth City Centre. The Committee approved the changes for a trial period of 12 months.

Following the trial, the Report No 17/213 to the Environment, Enterprise and Infrastructure Committee on the 14 June 2017 proposed to make the changes permanent and to roll out the changes to all other on-street parking within Perth and Kinross. The Committee approved the changes and now the Council wish to implement the changes.
