Statement of Reasons for Proposing to Make the Above Order

Following a detailed parking study carried out in 2013 and extensive public consultation during 2014, it was established that there was a need to introduce residents parking provision in areas in and around Prestwick town centre.

South Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on it by Sections 35, 45, 99, 101, 102 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Police Scotland in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the "South Ayrshire Council (Prestwick Town Centre) (Residents Permit Parking) Order 2016" and shall come into operation on Monday 26th September 2016.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"parking zone" means those roads within Prestwick town centre in which parking bays are situated;

"Council" means South Ayrshire Council;

"parking bay" means a space within a designated parking place as specified in Schedules 10 and 11 of the South Ayrshire Council (Town of Prestwick) (Waiting Restrictions) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2012;

"residents parking permit" ("permit") means a badge, disc or virtual permit issued by the Council, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, to a person who ordinarily resides in a dwelling house in one of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

3. This Order shall introduce the issue of residents parking permits at such price as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order and on such terms and conditions as described in Articles 4 to 11 of this Order to any person who ordinarily resides in a dwelling house in one of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order.
4. The residents parking permit shall be displayed on the nearside of the vehicle, behind the glass of the windscreen, in such a position as to ensure that the front side of the permit is clearly visible to any person standing at the front nearside of the vehicle.
5. Any vehicle which displays a valid residents parking permit in the manner specified in Article 4 of this Order shall be permitted to park without limit of time, in a parking bay within any of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
6. As regards the issue of residents parking permits -
 - (a) any owner or occupier who is resident in a dwelling house in one of the roads specified in Schedule 1 to this Order may apply to the Council for the issue of a residents parking permit (subject to a maximum of two permits per residence) allowing a vehicle to be left in a parking bay within one of the roads specified in Schedule 2 to this Order.
Such application shall be made in a manner determined by the Council and the applicant shall provide such information as the Council may require in order to verify that the issue of a permit will be valid; and
 - (b) the Council, on being satisfied that the applicant has provided the information required in paragraph (a) of this Article, shall issue to the applicant on payment of the sum detailed in Schedule 3 to this Order a permit as referred to in this Article and as described in Article 2 of this Order, to be used as described in Articles 4 and 5 of this Order.
7. A valid residents parking permit issued shall include any identifying mark specified by the Council, with an indication of the residents area to which that permit relates.
8. A residents parking permit holder as defined in Article 6 of this Order may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and shall receive a refund for the unused complete months on a pro rata basis, less an administrative charge as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order.
9. The Council may, by giving 28 days' notice in writing served on the permit holder at the address shown on the application for the permit, or at such other address believed to be the permit holder's residence at the time, withdraw a permit if-
 - (a) the residents parking permit holder ceases to be a resident at the address for which the permit is issued upon which the appropriate refund as referred to in Article 8 of this Order shall be made by the Council to the permit holder; or
 - (b) the Council issues a duplicate or replacement permit under the provisions of Article 10 of this Order.

10. A duplicate or replacement permit may be issued on application if -
- (a) a permit is mutilated or defaced or faded so that the identifying mark as referred to in Article 7 of this Order is illegible when the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council and shall apply for issue under paragraph (a) of Article 6 of this Order of a duplicate or replacement permit which, when issued on payment of an administration fee as specified in Schedule 3 to this Order, shall render the original permit invalid; or
 - (b) a permit is lost or destroyed when the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue of a duplicate or replacement permit under paragraph (a) of Article 6 of this Order and paragraph (a) of this Article; or
 - (c) a permit holder ceases to be the owner of the vehicle for which the permit was originally issued when the permit holder shall surrender the permit and may apply for issue under paragraph (a) of Article 6 of this Order of a replacement permit in respect of any new vehicle at no further charge, such replacement permit rendering the original permit invalid.
11. The provisions of this Order shall apply equally to a duplicate or replacement permit as for original permit.
