(AYR TOWN CENTRE) (RESIDENTS' PARKING) (CIVIL ENFORCEMENT) ORDER 2012

South Ayrshire Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by Sections 35, 45, 99, 101, 102, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended, the Road Traffic (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (South Ayrshire Council) Designation Order 2012 and the Road Traffic Act 1991 and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Constable of Strathclyde Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 hereby makes the following Order:-

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the "South Ayrshire Council (Ayr Town Centre) Residents' Parking) (Civil Enforcement) Order 2012" and shall come into operation on Saturday the First day of September, Two Thousand and Twelve.

Interpretation

2. In this Order the following expressions have the meanings hereby assigned to them:-

"central parking zone" means those roads within Ayr town centre in which parking bays are situated;

"the Council" means South Ayrshire Council;

"parking bay" means a space within a designated parking place as specified in Schedules 1 and 2 of the South Ayrshire Council (Ayr Town Centre) (Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2011;

"residents' parking permit" ("permit") means a badge, disc or virtual permit issued by the Council, in accordance with the provisions of this Order, to a person who ordinarily resides in a dwellinghouse in the area within Ayr town centre that falls within the central parking zone.

"vehicle" unless the context otherwise requires, means a vehicle of any description and includes a machine or implement of any kind drawn or propelled along roads whether or not by mechanical power;

3. This Order shall introduce the issue of residents' parking permits at such price as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order and on such terms and conditions as described in Articles 4 to 12 of this Order to any person who ordinarily resides in a

dwellinghouse in the area within Ayr town centre that falls within the central parking zone.

4. The central parking zone is divided into three residents' sub-zones as specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order which detail the lengths of roads contained in the sub-zones A1, A2 and A3 respectively.
5. The residents' parking permit shall be displayed on the nearside of the vehicle, behind the glass of the windscreen, in such a position as to ensure that the front side of the permit is clearly visible to any person standing at the front nearside of the vehicle.
6. Any vehicle which displays a valid residents' parking permit in the manner specified in Article 5 of this Order shall be permitted to park without limit of time, in a parking bay within the residents' sub-zone for which that permit is valid.
7. As regards the issue of residents' parking permits -
 - (a) any owner or occupier who is resident in a dwellinghouse in the area within Ayr town centre that falls within the central parking zone may apply to the Council for the issue of a residents' parking permit allowing a vehicle to be left in a parking bay within the residents' sub-zone in which that dwellinghouse lies, as specified in Schedules 1, 2 and 3 to this Order. Such application shall be made in a manner determined by the Council and the applicant shall provide such information as the Council may require in order to verify that the issue of a permit will be valid; and
 - (b) the Council, on being satisfied that the applicant has provided the information required in paragraph (a) of this Article, shall issue to the applicant on payment of the sum detailed in Schedule 4 to this Order a permit as referred to in this Article and as described in Article 2 of this Order, to be used as described in Articles 5 and 6 of this Order.
8. A valid residents' parking permit issued shall include any identifying mark specified by the Council, with an indication of the residents' sub-zone to which that permit relates.
9. A residents' parking permit holder as defined in Article 7 of this Order may surrender a permit to the Council at any time and shall receive a refund for the unused complete months on a pro rata basis, less an administrative charge as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order.
10. The Council may, by giving 28 days notice in writing served on the permit holder at the address shown on the application for the permit, or at such other address believed to be the permit holder's residence at the time, withdraw a permit if-
 - (a) the residents' parking permit holder ceases to be a resident at the address for which the permit is issued upon which the appropriate refund as referred to in Article 9 of this Order shall be made by the Council to the permit holder; or

- (b) the Council issues a duplicate or replacement permit under the provisions of Article 11 of this Order.

11. A duplicate or replacement permit may be issued on application if -

- (a) a permit is mutilated or defaced or faded so that the identifying mark as referred to in Article 8 of this Order is illegible when the permit holder shall surrender the permit to the Council and shall apply for issue under paragraph (a) of Article 7 of this Order of a duplicate or replacement permit which, when issued on payment of an administration fee as specified in Schedule 4 to this Order, shall render the original permit invalid; or
- (b) a permit is lost or destroyed when the permit holder may apply to the Council for the issue of a duplicate or replacement permit under paragraph (a) of Article 7 of this Order and paragraph (a) of this Article; or
- (c) a permit holder ceases to be the owner of the vehicle for which the permit was originally issued when the permit holder shall surrender the permit and may apply for issue under paragraph (a) of Article 7 of this Order of a replacement permit in respect of any new vehicle at no further charge, such replacement permit rendering the original permit invalid.

12. The provisions of this Order shall apply equally to a duplicate or replacement permit as for original permit.

13. The Order specified in Schedule 5 to this Order is hereby revoked.
